OVERVIEW

The Making Water Work Irrigation Farm Plans Support program is available for landholders that intend to undertake irrigation for agricultural purposes in the Lower Fitzroy region that have supplemented water allocations or are in the process of finalising a supplemented water allocation either from Rookwood Weir, Eden Bann Weir or the Fitzroy Barrage or alternatively an unsupplemented water allocation from the Lower Fitzroy Water Management Area.

Please note that a Farm Plan is a requirement for any irrigator to comply with the Rookwood Weir Land Management Code of Practice and the Queensland Government's Reef Regulations for new or expanding irrigation of five hectares or greater.

Applicants must be able to address and satisfactorily answer the below questions to apply for support under the program.
