What is a small business?

(ABS 2025; Clark et al. 2012)

- Less than 20 employees
- Mostly sole traders
- Mostly located outside major central business districts
- Mostly start-ups rather than acquisitions
- Many are home-based businesses
- Mostly service industries
- Mostly labour intensive



7 distinguishing features of small businesses

(Reynolds et al. 2000)

- 1. Strong owner influence
- 2. Centralised control
- 3. Limited ability to obtain finance
- 4. Narrow product/market mix
- 5. Intuitive decisions are common
- 6. Strong desire for independence
- 7. Lack of planning



Trends in small business

- Growing numbers of women owner/managers
- Increasing number of franchises
- Growing number of company and trust structures
- Increasing number of casual workers
- Increasing number of young workers
- Increasing adoption of technology



Reasons why small businesses fail

Approximately 60% of start-ups do not survive the first five years of trading with the main reasons being:

- 1. Lack of leadership and management skills
- 2. Limited long-term planning
- 3. Lack of market research, promotion, and insufficient sales
- 4. Lack of understanding about finance and cash flow
- 5. Lack of anticipation of external business environmental changes
- 6. Poor governance structures

Key success factors

- 1. Work 'on' your business as well as 'in' your business
- 2. Develop a clear vision and communicate to all stakeholders
- 3. Prioritise and focus on the important and urgent issues
- 4. Be responsive to customer
- 5. Innovate to create a competitive advantage and be unique
- 6. Build a committed team and lead by example
- 7. Develop a long-term plan and review regularly
- 8. Embrace change (without compromising your values)
- 9. Constantly aim to improve
- 10. Seek assistance and advice



Business plans

Definition: A collection of long-term goals with accompanying actions to achieve a sustainable competitive advantage Benefits include:

- More effective management of your business as activities are organised
- Improves your ability to control your business as you monitor progress
- Develops resilience by anticipating changes
- Enables calculated change initiatives to innovate
- Empowers business owners to increase risk appetite
- Builds confidence, motivation and feeling of empowerment
- Can be liberating, providing a sense of freedom
- Helps to secure funding from loans, grants and investors
- Can increase likelihood of sale



Most small businesses operate without a business plan

Reasons include:

- I just don't have the time, I'm too busy
- I don't know where to start
- I don't know how to put it all together
- What's the point, what do I do with it?
- Business plans are only for big business
- I'm a doer not a thinker
- It's too expensive
- I'm too impatient



Business Planning Course

- Developed to help small businesses write a business plan
- Expanded to Sunshine Coast, Gympie and Fraser Coast in 2021


